Kamran Kadkhoda, Ph.D., SM(ASCP), D(ABMM), D(ABMLI) Medical Director, Immunopathology Lab Main Campus-Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, OH

Dr. Kamran Kadkhoda is the medical director of the immunopathology laboratory at the Cleveland Clinic-Main Campus, Cleveland, Ohio. After finishing his Ph.D. in Immunology in 2005, he did a postdoctoral fellowship in infection & Immunity and also Allergy at the University of Manitoba, Canada from 2005-2008. Then he started his clinical microbiology fellowship at the same university and the affiliated hospitals from 2008-2010, after which he started working as staff member overseeing a serology lab at Manitoba provincial laboratory for 8 years. Following this, he joined the Cleveland Clinic, Cleveland, Ohio in 2018.

Dr. Kadkhoda is a Diplomate of both the American Board of Medical Microbiology (ABMM) and the Medical Laboratory Immunology (ABMLI), and a Fellow of the Canadian College of Microbiologists. He also possesses a New York State Laboratory Director Certificate of Qualification in Diagnostic Immunology and the American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP) Certificate of Specialist in Microbiology.

He has nearly 60 publications with special focus on immunology, lab diagnosis of infectious diseases, among others and so far, ten 1st-authored or co-authored papers on COVID-19.
