Dr. Roshini S. Abraham is a diplomate of the American Board of Medical Laboratory Immunology (ABMLI), and a fellow of the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology (AAAAI) and the Clinical Immunology Society (CIS). She is a Past President of the Clinical Immunology Society

(CIS; 2017-2019). She is currently the Chair of the Document Development Committee of the Clinical Laboratory Standards Institute (CLSI) on Newborn Screening for Severe Combined Immunodeficiencies, Chair of the Immunology Special Interest Group for the American Society of Clinical Pathology Curriculum Education Research Special Advisory Committee (CER-SAC), Co-Chair of the Immunology Clinical Domain Working Group for ClinGen, and Co-Chair of the Antibody Deficiencies ClinGen Gene Curation Expert Panel. She is the Lead for the Primary Immunodeficiency Treatment Consortium (PIDTC) Pilot Projects. She is also a member of the Board of Scientific Counselors of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center, and an Associate Editor for the Journal of Clinical Immunology. She has published 121 peer-reviewed articles, 21 book chapters and over 150 abstracts.
